These developments reflect our ongoing commitment to providing a high-quality learning environment and preparing our students with the knowledge, skills, and experiences they need for the future.

We have continued to innovate with our academic program to further enrich and strengthen it and you read more about that within these pages.

As another school year comes to a close, we are grateful for the partnership and support of our students, parents, and staff. The challenges and achievements of the past year have reinforced the strength of our school community and our shared commitment to learning and growth.

In the year ahead, we will continue to enhance our programs, facilities, and learning experiences while remaining focused on the well-being and success of every student. We look forward to welcoming our community back for another year of discovery, achievement, and meaningful experiences.

Campus Infrastructure Development/ Curriculum Development

We have made significant progress in enhancing our academic program this year and have plans to continue next year. Our planned academic enhancements next year include:

- Comprehensive enhancement of the Class VII program - this will include curriculum restructuring, greater emphasis on student-centered learning, more hands-on and inquiry-based experiences, updated learning resources and textbooks, and the continued development of the Learning for Life and Technology & Media programs to better prepare students for the challenges of secondary education.
- Revision and strengthening of the Nursery Bangla curriculum to ensure a more engaging, developmentally appropriate, and language-rich learning experience for our youngest learners.
- Ongoing review and refinement of curricula across multiple subjects and grade levels to ensure alignment with best educational practices and the evolving needs of students. This will include further strengthening of the Social Studies curriculum through updated content.
- Review and updating of selected English and Bangla literature and language texts to provide students with high-quality, engaging, and age-appropriate language development experiences.
- Introduction of new Learning for Life texts in the lower elementary classes, supporting the development of social-emotional skills, personal well-being, character education, and responsible decision-making.
- Continued investment in educational resources, teacher professional development, and classroom materials to support high-quality teaching and learning across all campuses.

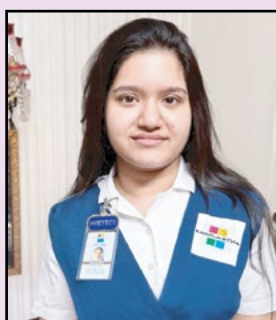

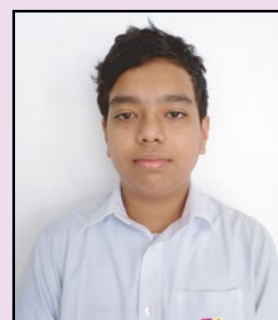
