I write this note with hope – that the pandemic is coming under control due to our government’s vaccination program and that we can soon start to return to a semblance of normalcy. Since we have been able to start some in-person classes in our hybrid program, it has been wonderful to see the joyful faces of our students and to feel the buzz of their presence on campus again. We hope we can sustain and expand to increase the in-person classes over time.

Of course, we need to remain cautious and careful always, the pandemic continues to take a heavy toll on us emotionally, mentally and physically – but the resumption of in-person classes is certainly a ray of hope!

While managing the pandemic, setting schedules, and working out the structure of the hybrid program has taken up a lot of our time, and our faculty remain so busy with online classes and home tasks, we have continued to move forward with some development in different areas of our operations. Here are the highlights:


- We have continued the development of our **academic program**—we have implemented the restructuring of our Class II curriculum. We have also been working on our English and Bangla curriculum in the junior school and have done a lot of work on fine tuning our literacy curriculum. You can read more about these developments later in this newsletter.
- Our junior campuses now have a professional nurse and a qualified counselor – who will add significant benefit to our students especially now that we have resumed in-person classes.
- We also spent a lot of time developing our campus infrastructure and protocols to manage **a return to campus** during the pandemic. This work entailed writing a detailed policy and conducting extensive training, upgrading our campus infrastructure in a number of ways, and designing health and safety protocols. A huge amount of work went into the preparations, which helped us a lot to ensure a smooth start to in-person classes. Managing in-person classes themselves have been quite time consuming but it has been good to start slowly and ensure we all are comfortable with ‘the new normal’ and all of the COVID protocols that are now in place.

We also produced excellent exam results last year – with a great deal of hard work and input from our teachers and management, which was unprecedented and quite unexpected. Our graduates were accepted in many reputed institutions of higher learning – which always makes us proud. Congratulations to all!

The pages of this newsletter are full of achievements and milestones for our students and faculty; it is so wonderful that we have so many achievements to be proud of, despite living through the pandemic. Thank you to all the families in our community for their ongoing support and cooperation – our partnership has never been stronger. We have worked closely together to do our best for our students and hope this strong relationship between home and school can continue in the future.

An Update on Curriculum Development

We have implemented a revised structure in the curriculum of Class II – apart from adding new subjects like “Learning for Life” and “Dance” we have also modernized and updated the curriculum and teaching approaches. Unfortunately some of the benefits will not be conveyed very well through online learning but we hope to meet most of our learning objectives and look forward to further enhancing the curriculum once we return to campus full time.

We have been learning a lot about the Science of Reading – a whole area of research that tells us the most effective ways to teach reading to all students – including those who struggle to read. We are incorporating best practices into teaching and conducting training for our staff and we will do a lot more work in this area in the coming year. We want to ensure every child in our school becomes a confident and fluent reader and will work hard to meet this goal.


We have also implemented a revised science curriculum in the junior school which is more experiential and hands-on. Some aspects of the curriculum could not be implemented through online learning but we are looking forward to incorporating them into in-person classes soon.

Discipline Month




