Message from the Managing Director

To the Scholastica Community:

As we come to the successful close of our first term, I would like to thank our students, staff, and families for their continued commitment and support. It has been a positive and productive start to the academic year, with strong engagement across academic and co-curricular areas. Alongside teaching and learning, we remain focused on strengthening our systems, programs, and learning environments to better support student growth and wellbeing. Below are some key areas of curriculum and whole-school development currently underway.

As part of our continued commitment to enhancing the learning environment and student experience, the following initiatives are currently being implemented across the school:

- **High School Washroom Upgrades**
Washroom facilities across our high school campuses are being renovated and improved to ensure greater comfort, hygiene, and accessibility.
- **A Level Lounge & Media and Design Lab Development**
The A Level student lounge is being further enhanced, and our Media and Design labs are being expanded to better support creative and practical learning across both high school campuses.
- **Class VI Classroom Environment Enhancements**
Classroom furniture and learning spaces for Class VI have been upgraded to align with updated curriculum requirements and modern teaching approaches.
- **Science Laboratory Upgrades**
Science laboratories have been updated to meet CAIE specifications, enabling students to sit their public examinations within our own campuses.
- **Expanded CCTV Coverage**
CCTV coverage is being increased across high school campuses to further enhance student safety and campus security.
- **Strengthening Student Awareness Programs**
We are structuring and enhancing our student awareness programs, including homeroom sessions conducted by class teachers and parent awareness programs held on Report Card Days, to ensure consistent messaging and stronger home-school partnerships.
- **Enhancing Student Council Processes**
Processes for the student councils in both high schools have been reviewed and improved to allow for greater student agency, leadership development, and student voice in school life.
- **Student ID Pictures**
The school's SRD unit is now taking pictures of all students for their ID cards, thereby eliminating the need for parents to submit pictures every year – a small change but with a big impact on convenience for parents!

We would like to extend our sincere thanks to our parents and guardians for the trust you place in us and for your continued cooperation and partnership. Your support plays a vital role in our students' success, and we look forward to working closely with you as we continue the journey of learning and growth together.


