As ever, we are progressing with our plans for further development and improvement. I have highlighted the main developments for next year below:

- We have done a lot of work on different aspects of our curriculum this year, and have plans for further development next year. Read more about all this work inside this newsletter.
- We have enhanced our extra-curricular and homeroom programs: character and moral education, sports, the arts, field trips, foreign trips, competitions, tournaments – in particular, we have expanded the number of tournaments and events held on campus, and developed more homeroom programs focusing on character education.

Thank you to all the members of our community who contribute in different ways to make Scholastica a truly special institution. I hope you have a restful summer and see you next session!

An Update on Curriculum Development

Despite several challenges, our management and faculty have continued to work on numerous development projects to enhance the quality of the school in various aspects, under the supervision and guidance of the Curriculum Development Unit (CDU). The main areas are listed here:

- We have been working hard to upgrade the teaching methods and resources used in Maths. We are proud of the developments we see in our Maths programs, with a greater emphasis on conceptual understanding and mastery of key skills; we will keep working on it next year.
- In recent years we have upgraded the way
 we teach Literature in Bangla and English;
 next year we will introduce new novels in
 the middle school that we hope will
 continue to develop students' love of
 reading, and also challenge them to think
 about their lives and society more deeply.

- We have also upgraded our physical education and sports program, introducing some more sports and upgrading teaching methods and the administration of sports teams. We have also introduced a fitness tracking system and plan to introduce fitness tests from next year. This will help us to improve the fitness levels of students.
- This year, we started revising our Social Studies curriculum. We will work on this more next year, including workshops and detailed curriculum planning. We will implement a new social studies curriculum in our junior and middle school from the following year. We will also upgrade our Ethics, Religion and Moral Science curriculum for next year, to be implemented in the following year.
- We introduced new subjects at the O' and A' Level this year and we will keep working closely with our teachers to ensure high standards in all subjects. We offer a wide range of subjects at these levels, more than most other schools – this allows us to cater to the interests of different students.
- As you know, this year we expanded the structure and upgraded the resources in our Playgroup program and so far we have all been happy with the outcome. We will upgrade the teaching methods, resources, classrooms and assessment tools used in Nursery next year! Our enhanced Nursery program will include daily physical education activities and the introduction of social studies and Bangla.
- We have also upgraded our digital education systems and have been sending home links for students to watch and practice to enrich their learning. We are developing more tools for communication for next year.
- We have developed more textbooks and workbooks, in collaboration with our sister concern which is a publishing company. We are happy to introduce a new Bangladesh Studies text for Class III and re-designed Selected Poems books for Class I-IV. We are also happy with the response to the new Bangla language workbooks in Class I and II; we are developing more in the series.

Awareness Programs

Every year we run awareness programs to develop important skills, open minds and encourage students to practice being a good person. In this term, the following programs were conducted in different campuses:

- Career Week- A program for class VI to XII students where guests from different professional backgrounds are invited to share their experiences. They discuss about their careers, and the requirements and challenges of each profession.
- Let's be fit and clean- The students took part in a healthy food parade and presented different songs and a role play which explained the importance of a healthy lifestyle and good habits.
- Bring out the best in you- The students expressed their imaginations through stories, poems, and art.
- Discipline Month- a whole month designed for students to practice good discipline and make it a part of their daily habits and behavior.
- "Keep Calm and Say No to Drugs"- drug awareness program by Prothom Alo. This was an interactive session conducted to explicate the fatal effects of drug addiction.
- Mind your manners- Through this program students are reminded about the importance of etiquette and manners in their day-to-day life.
- World Book Day- This is observed to encourage children to explore the pleasures of reading by providing them with the opportunity to enrich their personal library.
- Healthy food for healthy life- information is shared about the importance of keeping up good health through a balanced life.
- World Health Day- Students conducted different activities to raise awareness about the importance of maintaining healthy body and healthy mind.
- Personal Hygiene- Sessions in small groups were conducted for the senior girls to raise awareness on personal hygiene and presentation at all times.
- Awareness on "My Body Safety Rules"
 with Yellow Brick Road- Session to educate
 children regarding their physical safety, and
 how to address wrong and right physical
 actions. Our own counselors also conducted
 more activities with children on these issues
 of personal safety.

Through the Classroom Window – Physical Fitness

We know that physical fitness plays an important role in lifelong good health, and we hope to give our students a good foundation through our physical education classes. This year, we designed and did a 'soft launch' of a series of fitness tests for classes KGI to X. These tests are done to capture the fitness levels of our students and check to see if they are meeting our targets of achievement. The tests were designed after a lot of research to base them on international best practice, and the targets of achievements have been set to be age-appropriate. We hope this will help us to ensure all of our students achieve minimum levels of fitness every year.


